

Discussion Question Message #1 Living For Eternity:

- 1) If you could have one thing in this world (popularity, perfect looks, some material good you've always wanted, superior athletic abilities, the perfect boyfriend or girlfriend), be honest with yourself, which would you want the most? Why? And in what ways would having this one person, thing, or ability, bring your peace and joy?
- 2) In what ways are you different or is your lifestyle different from the rest of your friends at school?
- 3) What does it mean (or what would it look like) for you personally, to live for eternity today?

Discussion Questions Message #2 Wholly Renewed:

- 1) If you consider yourself saved by Jesus Christ, then why do you (why do all Christians) still struggle with sin?
- 2) What is the difference between being changed from the inside out verses just doing good things on the outside but remaining sinful?
- 3) How do we pursue complete renewal? Why can't we do this ourselves? Who should we place our focus upon and why?

Discussion Questions Message #3 The Old Self Must Die Part 1:

- 1) What does it mean to put to death what is earthly in us?
- 2) In what ways do you see yourself becoming more like Jesus? If you do not see any spiritual growth in your life, then what are the things or who are the people that are holding you back from pursuing Christ-like growth?
- 3) Who are the people in your life that help you grow to be more like Jesus? Why is it important to surround yourself with people who encourage you to live for Jesus?
- 4) What are the consequences for not putting sin to death?

Discussion Questions Message #4 The Old Self Must Die Part 2:

- 1) What are the personal sins against God that you struggle with?
- 2) How can you keep your mind pure in the midst of what is promoted via the media?
- 3) What are the social sins against God and people that you struggle with?
- 4) Why is it so destructive to bottle up bitterness and anger?

Discussion Questions Message #5 Wholly Transformed Hearts:

1. What characterizes a wholly renewed heart?
2. What gives evidence that your heart is truly being renewed?
3. The two results of wholly renewed hearts are that we bear with one another and we forgive each other; how does this apply to your life individually? Who are the people that God is calling you to forgive, love, and bear with? (Only share if it is not too personal, other wise please share with your counselors in private).
4. Why is it so important for Christians to learn to forgive each other, as well as to forgive those who are outside of the Church?

Discussion Questions Message #6 Wholly Renewed Priorities:

- 1) What are your major priorities in life? (Christ, School, athletics, music/band, friends, relationships with the opposite gender, popularity, etc.?) Why are these priorities for you?
- 2) In what ways do you make God's Word a priority in your life? What are the things, people, or activities that keep you from studying and falling in love with God's Word?
- 3) How does the study of God's Word impact your praise and worship of God?
- 4) What would it look like for you personally at home, at school, among your friends, at church, in your extra curricular activities, to live for the glory of Christ' name?
