Spiritual Inventory

A major obligation of all churches is to be *spiritually worthy* to spread the Gospel. But churches can be worthy only as individual members are worthy. Our Lord said, “Go ye,” but He also said, “Tarry ye”. The tarrying precedes the going. Had the disciples gone before they were empowered by the Holy Spirit on the Day of Pentecost, it would have been a spiritual disaster.

It would seem that the seed, (the Word of God), would produce the same fruit regardless of the spiritual condition of the sower. It does not work that way! *“The identical message preached by men of differing degrees of godliness will produce different kinds of converts and results ... Christianity will always produce after its kind,”* (A. W. Tozer).
